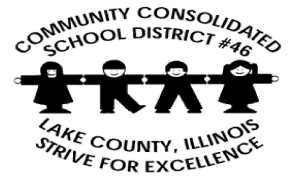

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Community Consolidated School District 46's Curriculum must include Erin's Law, an annual state mandated, age-appropriate sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention program for students Pre-K through 12th grade. Governor Pat Quinn signed Erin's Law in January 2013.

It is estimated that one in four girls and one in six boys are sexually abused by the time they are eighteen. It is also estimated that about 90 percent of the abusers are known to the child and include relatives, neighbors, babysitters, and family acquaintances.

Erin's Law requires our schools to educate students on safe touches and unsafe touches; safe secrets and unsafe secrets; and how to "get away and tell today." Children will also learn how to recognize child sexual abuse, and reduce their vulnerability and encourage them to report abuse.

The curriculum will vary from grade to grade, however it will be developmentally appropriate per grade level. In Pre-School, students receive developmentally appropriate lessons presented by the Zacharias Center. In grades K-4, students will watch a pre-approved video, titled, "It's Your Body: You're In Charge," that meets the requirements of Erin's Law. If you would like to preview this video, please contact your building administrator.

For grades K-4, videos will be shown to students between January 8, 2018 and January 31, 2018. In 5th - 8th Grade, age developmentally appropriate instruction will occur during students' health class.

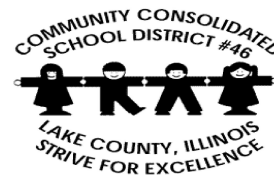

Estimados padres y tutores,

Comunidad Consolidated School District de 46 plan de estudios debe incluir la Ley de Erin, un mandato del estado, el acoso sexual adecuada a la edad y el conocimiento de asalto y programa de prevención para los estudiantes de Pre-K hasta el 12 grado. El gobernador Pat Quinn firmó la ley de Erin en enero de 2013.

Se estima que una de cada cuatro niñas y uno de cada seis niños son abusados sexualmente antes de la edad de dieciocho. Asimismo, se estima que alrededor del 90 por ciento de los abusadores son conocidos por el niño e incluyen parientes, vecinos, niñeras y conocidos de la familia.

Ley de Erin requiere nuestras escuelas para educar a los estudiantes sobre los contactos físicos seguros y contactos físicos no seguros; secretos seguros y secretos que no son seguros; y la forma de "escapar y contar." Los niños también aprenderán a reconocer el abuso sexual infantil y reducir su vulnerabilidad y los anima a reportar el abuso.

El plan de estudios varían de un grado a otro, sin embargo, será apropiado para el desarrollo por nivel de grado. En Pre-escolar, los estudiantes reciben lecciones apropiadas de desarrollo presentados por el Centro de Zacarías. En los grados K-4, los estudiantes ven un video pre-aprobado, titulado, "Es Su cuerpo: usted está a cargo", que cumpla con los requisitos de la Ley de Erin. Si desea previsualizar el vídeo, póngase en contacto con el administrador del edificio.

Para los grados K-4, los vídeos se mostrarán a los estudiantes entre el 8 de enero de 2018 y 31 de enero de 2018. En 5 - 8 grado, la edad apropiada para el desarrollo de instrucciones que ocurrirá durante la clase de salud de los estudiantes.
