Continued Discussion of the Print Center Contract

The district is looking at savings of up to \$40,000 just by downsizing the copiers. Contracts are coming due at scattered times. Several companies are looking to buy out the other contracts to make them all due at the same time. We currently pay in equipment lease and clicks per document.
