Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

It's hard to believe that Halloween is fast approaching. In keeping with our TEAM concept, on October 31st, each class will be conducting various TEAM building activities at some point during the day. While no formal school-wide Halloween parties are planned at Frederick School, we do understand that some children may choose to dress up on that day. Each individual teacher will determine if costumes can be worn. We ask that all parents and students follow the District #46 Holiday Advisory Committee Implementation Guidelines effective for Halloween Celebrations:

- * While costumes are allowable, it is important to take into consideration that some families are deeply offended by the representation of witches, ghosts, vampires, devils, werewolves, and goblins. Please be courteous when assisting your child in choosing a costume.
- * While staff may make suggestions regarding costume theme, costumes are the choice of the students.
- * Weapons and other suggestions of overt violence **are not allowed**.
- * District 46 staff reserves the right to remove disruptive costumes or portions thereof.

Frederick School Celebrates Red Ribbon Week:

Red Ribbon Week is a national effort for drug prevention and education. Red Ribbon Week honors the memory of Special Agent Enrique "Kiki" Camarena who lost his life to keep the children and communities safe from drug use. The mission of the Red Ribbon Campaign is the creation of a drug free America. Frederick School will be celebrating Red Ribbon Week from Monday, Oct. 24 through Friday, October 28th.

On Thursday October 20th the Camfel Productions' assembly, "Worth It" will demonstrate that the choices that students make today will directly impact their future. They will be taught to take control of the decisions they make, and that through perseverance and self-discipline, they can make the right choices – choices that will lead them to success in school and in life.

On Monday, October 24th the band students will play their instruments as the students arrive to school. Red, white and blue bracelets stating "I Elect To Be Drug Free" will be passed out to students on Monday and students are encouraged to wear a "crazy hat or hair."
