Thank you for joining us at our Back to School Night on Thursday evening. We are always so happy to see so many of you on this very important night. Thank you for your time not only tonight, but throughout the upcoming year as we work together to help all of our students learn and grow. A big thank you as well to all of you who have volunteered to help with events throughout the year. The PTO is busy planning for this year and is working on our big community events, the Fun Run, the Fall Festival and the Family Dance.

As you know, the safety of our children is our top priority. At Meadowview School we address these areas in a variety of ways. We will conduct our safety drills throughout the year. However, at the beginning of the year we are sure to get one practice in with each of the drills in order to make sure our students are familiar with the necessary routines in their new classroom

Visiting School- When you arrive at the building you will find a buzz in system on the front door. If this is the first time you are visiting the building, we will ask for your driver's license. Your license is scanned in order to print your visitor's badge. Please do not be offended if a staff member asks to see your visitor's badge or guides you to the school office. These procedures are necessary to ensure the safety of our children.

Safety Drills- Throughout the year we will be practicing three emergency drills: fire, severe weather, and lock down drills.

Arrival- If you are driving your children to school please drop them off in the main parking lot. Do not drop your children off on Lexington Lane. Please pull up as far forward as possible along the curb. Children should exit the car on the passenger side only. (The front circle is for buses only.)

Dismissal- Buses will pick up the students in the front circle. The main parking lot is for parent pick up.

Parents who plan to pick up their children after school must have a colored parking pass in order to enter the main parking lot before 2:15. The parking lot is only open to the specified color at the designated time. See below. Students are dismissed according to the assigned parking pass at the following times:

1. Blue - students are dismissed at 2:11
2. Red - students are dismissed at 2:13

Walkers and bus riders are dismissed at 2:15 (a Green flag is raised once the lot is open).




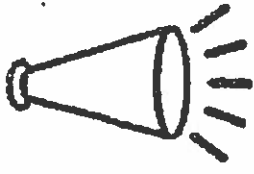
The Mock Newbery Club is an annual event that is now a tradition at Meadowview School. Younger siblings are excited to get to 4th grade and become committee members themselves!
