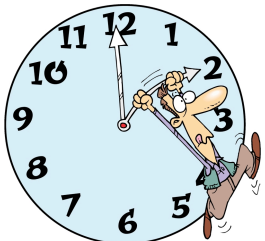
School begins at 9:20. Please follow your late start bus arrival times.
